

Preliminary Flood Risk Assessment (PFRA)	An assessment of floods that have taken place in the past and floods that could take place in the future. They considers flooding from surface water runoff, groundwater and ordinary watercourses. Surface Water Management Plan (SWMP)	A plan which outlines the preferred surface water management strategy in a given location.
